

## 7.2.3 Metadata Assigned to Questions

The Project Manager may create metadata for the project which may or may not be mandatory. These metadata are used in items. Users can view reports based on the type of metadata.

Column	Description
<b>Content</b>	The metadata contents created for the project and used in items.
<b># Written</b>	The number of items written for the corresponding metadata content.
<b># Accepted</b>	The number of items accepted for the corresponding metadata content.
<b># Rejected</b>	The number of items returned for the corresponding metadata content.
